This applies to our spiritual lives as Christians as well. Most people read the bible and pray when they are in trouble or need some kind of help and when the problem is solved they don't pray or even read the bible again. It looks like they see God as cash machine (ATM); and only go to God when they need help.

When Jesus was teaching his disciples how to pray in Matthew 6:11, he said 'give us this day our daily bread (NKJ). Jesus was emphasising how important it is to rely fully on God for our day by day sustenance. This describes the original plan of God for mankind in Genesis 1:26 where God intended to make man in his image and likeness so that there will be constant flow of fellowship in the relationship.

Continual Communication:

Since we have the image of God, we can only rule and subdue the earth when we have continual communication with him so that he will help us along the way Psalm 90:12.

It is not surprising when Paul in Philippians 3:10 was craving to know the Lord Jesus and fellowship of His suffering. God is Love and He is keen to have an intimate fellowship with us Psalm 16:11, and not just provide our needs.

Daily Bible Reading:

Daily bible reading will help us to get closer to God because it is the breath of God 2 Timothy 3:16. In fact through the bible reading, we are able to know the truth in life John 8:32, we accept who we are 1John 1:8-9 and correct our mistakes Hebrews 12:6. This will help us to enjoy making disciples for Christ, Matthew 28:19; and not making money for ourselves Matthew 6:33.

If you have not started reading the bible at all, start reading from Genesis through to revelation cover to cover. Use study bible NKJ or NIV so that you can read the notes around it. Sometimes you will get other references which will be helpful when you read them. Find a Church that teaches on the bible and not on any prayer book or type of prophecies. It will be helpful to have a leader or your minister you can rely on to help you understand reading the bible. Before you start reading, pray and ask the Holy Spirit to explain to you what you are reading.

It might take you a while to finish reading through the whole bible but that's OK, you will understand God better and even when you read it over and over again you will enjoy life to the fullness, Joshua 1:8.

Divine revelation will help us to understand this information. Enjoy the journey of personal bible reading cover to cover.
